

Apple iOS Making Phone Calls Using Siri



Did you know that it is possible to make phone calls on your iPhone, or iPad with cellular capabilities, using Siri? Well, it most certainly is! To do this, follow these suggested steps:

1. Press and hold down the HOME button, or the Side button on devices without a Home button, until you hear a high pitch double bell tone. This indicates that Siri is listening to you. A message will be displayed which says "What can I help you with".
2. Now say "Call" followed by the name of the person you wish to call. Upon doing this, Siri will say "calling" followed by the name of the person you specified! How easy is that!?

Note: If the person you are calling has more than one telephone number, for example a landline and mobile, Siri will ask which number you want to use. Simply state the one you want and the call will be placed!

You can even call numbers that are not in your Contacts list! To do this, press and hold down the HOME button, or the Side button on devices without a Home button, until you hear the high pitch double bell tone. Then say, for example, "call 01483 456558". A second or two later, Siri will announce that the call is being made!
