Our Plan for 2025 to 2028



The **Surrey Coalition of Disabled People** is a group that helps Disabled people in Surrey. We have been doing this since 1997. In 2023, we became a charity to help even more people.



The Coalition helps Disabled people in many ways. We run programmes to get people active, work with the council and NHS, and campaign for disability rights. We also help with energy, food, and digital inclusion.



The Coalition wants to grow and help more Disabled people in Surrey. We need to reach more people and have stable funding to do this.



Our mission is to empower Disabled people to be active in the community. We work with health and social care partners to create services and policies. We campaign for rights and fill gaps in support.



In late 2025, we asked members and staff what we should focus on for the next three years. We wanted to know what we do well and what could be better by 2028



Disabled people are involved in decision-making. The Coalition used focus groups, discussions, and surveys to gather ideas. The strategy was created based on what was important to everyone.



In 2021, a census showed many people in Surrey have disabilities. Some have conditions that limit their daily activities, while others do not.



The Coalition's vision is a world where **difference is valued** and everyone has the same rights and opportunities. We want to campaign for equality.



Some weaknesses are staff capacity, influencing national decisions, and dealing with financial strain. We need to improve these areas to be more effective.



The Coalition has a **Risk Management Plan** to handle challenges. We want to diversify funding, work with local government, and improve data capture and reporting.



We have **Key Strategic Objectives** to reach more Disabled people, support the community, and secure future funding. We need to make changes to achieve these goals.



To work better, we plan to improve database systems, develop our board, and expand staff capacity. We want to offer more training for professionals and out-of-hours activities.



For **Finance and Income Generation**, we want to explore new funding sources. We aim to secure multi-year grants and create a fundraising strategy.



We plan to raise awareness of our work and reach more Disabled people in Surrey. We want to strengthen our brand and lead campaigns for change.



Involvement of Disabled people is key. We want to increase membership, ensure voices are heard, and offer more social inclusion activities.



We have **Annual Business Plan Objectives** to increase membership, secure funding, and improve data capture. We also want to expand team capacity and host fundraising events.



The Coalition is committed to making a positive impact on the lives of Disabled people in Surrey. We will continue to work towards their goals and adapt to challenges.
